



Software Training Up-Skilling Programmers to Java

(May & June/July Training Courses booked out in less than a month)

The **UCD School of Computer Science and Informatics** (www.csi.ucd.ie) together with UCD campus company **crovan** is offering training for IT professionals who have recently been made redundant. This is one of a number of initiatives that the School is currently undertaking to participate in the National Recovery Plan. The training will enable non-Java programmers to become familiar and proficient with Java and help to prepare them for the **Sun Certified Java Programming (SCJP)** qualification. UCD are offering two courses, one on the **“Foundations of Java”** and the other on **“Advanced Java”**, and it is the intention that both courses would be taken to bring a developer or programmer from another programming language into Java. Each course is of one week's duration and is based in UCD. At the end of each course the students will receive a letter of attendance, and on successful completion of an end-of-course examination they will receive a letter of proficiency from the School.

As all the courses are fully booked out, a waiting list is being compiled. Candidates that register on this **waiting list** (**“UCD Waiting list: Foundations of Java”** and **“UCD Waiting list: Advanced Java”**) will be given first choice of the following:

- **Any cancellation** that frees up a place for the June/July UCD Java courses (dates of which are **“UCD Foundation of Java”** 9:30-5:30 Thursday 25th June – Wednesday 1st July 2009 and **“UCD Advanced Java”** 9:30-5:30 Thursday 9th July – Wednesday 15th July 2009)
- **Possible future offering** of the relevant offering of the **“UCD Foundation of Java”** and/or the **“UCD Advanced Java”** in summer 2009.
- **A full refund** if no suitable course is offered, or indeed at any time on request from the candidate.

Requirements for admittance:

Programmers or IT professionals in non-Java
Access to a computer laptop or desktop
Unemployed or under threat of redundancy in previous 12 months
University education is not essential nor is any knowledge of Java technologies
